



Would the DMK Government Present the Monthly Report Card on November 1st?

DMK has given 505 poll promises to the people of Tamil Nadu during the 2021 assembly elections and many of those promises are yet to be fulfilled wherein I would like to bring to notice one particular poll promise (Poll promise number 491).

The poll promise number 491 as quoted in the DMK's election manifesto:

“A Ministry for New Schemes Implementation will be created and headed by a senior minister for the implementation of the following responsibilities-

- *A state level executive committee will be formed for faster implementation of the promises made in this election manifesto.*

- *All complaints received during “Ungal Thogudhiyil Stalin” election campaign will be addressed in the first 100 days.*

- *The CM will address a press conference on the 100th day to brief on the actions taken by this ministry.*

A review will be done by the CM on the first working day of every month. A report card will be presented to the Press on the actions taken by Kalaingar's government”.

It has been 173 days till date since DMK assumed office. The Hon'ble Chief Minister continues to say that they have fulfilled 200 poll promises in public gatherings and press meets however the most important poll promise of creating a new ministry for schemes implementation and monthly report card presentation to the press & media is yet to be fulfilled.

November 1st, 2021 marks the historic day when the states were divided on a linguistic basis as well as the first working day of the month. On this special day, I request the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu to fulfill the poll promise 491 by publishing and presenting the report card detailing their fulfilled promises as per the DMK election manifesto to the press.
